

Kerby's Mask Policy – May 3, 2021

The latest CDC guidelines state that fully vaccinated individuals can be outdoors without masks on. However, there is no change in previous guidance for being: outdoors in crowds, unvaccinated, or indoors.

Here is what this means for Kerby's:

A face-covering is required of all staff if you are:

- 1) In the store building.
- 2) In the greenhouse.
- 3) In the checkout tent.
- 4) Assisting customers within a distance of six feet.

If you are away from customers and other staff members, and in an outdoor location, you may remove your mask. However, given the indoor areas that we do have at the nursery, and the potential for interaction with a staff member or customer, you must have a face-covering with you at all times.

As the CDC issues new guidance on when and where it is safe to be without masks, we will continue to follow their recommendations and will modify our policies accordingly. As we begin the journey as a society back to a more normal life, remember that it is OK to get back to normal. We've been in pandemic mode for so long, that it is easy to forget the times that we felt more care-free and less suspicious of each other.
